Maintenance work on BSL Carbon Bake Furnace fume treatment system

BSL will be carrying out maintenance work on the smelter's Carbon Baking Furnace fume treatment system on **Wednesday 29th July and Thursday 30th July 2009.**

The maintenance shutdown is necessary to make sure that BSL fume scrubbing systems are operating effectively. The 24 hour shutdown will commence at **10.00pm** on Wednesday 29th July and be completed by **10.00pm the following day.**

There may be visible emissions coming from the BSL Carbon Baking Furnace fume treatment system during this period.

The start and continuation of the maintenance work is dependent on weather conditions such as wind speed and wind direction. This is to ensure that any emissions are dispersed quickly over vacant land areas to the west of BSL.

The shutdown will be taken within the boundaries of our environmental license.
